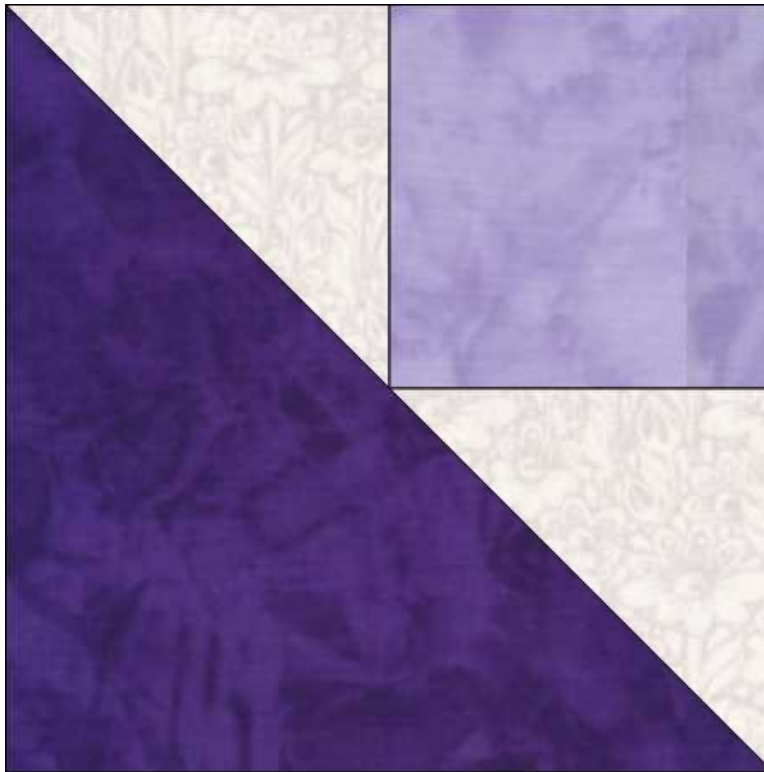

Mary's Triangles

Block size: 4 inches

Cutting:

- From dark purple cut two $4\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles.
- From background cut two $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles.
- From light purple cut two $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares.

Block:

Follow the instructions in the tutorial for making two units at a time.

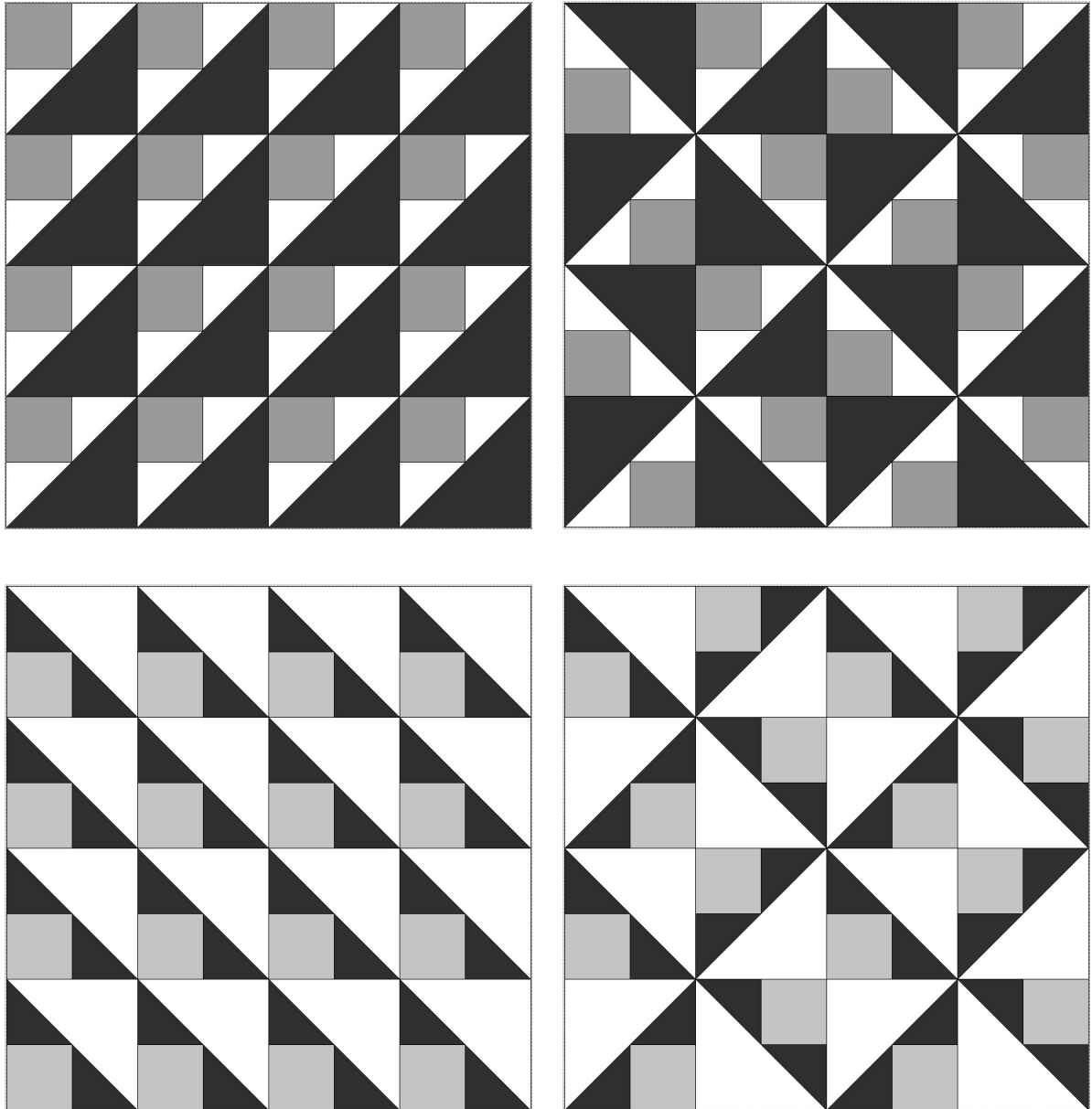
Stitch the small squares to the background rectangles and stitch these units together.

Press and snip the seam as shown and mark the sewing lines (take care!) Put these units RS together with dark purple rectangles and stitch along sewing lines.

Check before cutting apart.

Quilt Ideas

You can have a lot of fun playing with this unit just on its own to make a quilt. Try it with a rainbow kaleidoscope of colour, or stick to just one or two colour families. Alternate the lights and darks as well to get a completely different look.
